 facing down and $W$ up
25- $1 \mathrm{c}+2 \mathrm{c}$ BiL | $1 \mathrm{~W}+2 \mathrm{M} \& 2 \mathrm{~W}+1 \mathrm{M}$ turn $\mathrm{LH}^{1 ⁄ 2}$; BiL | continue LH turns, 1 c crossing down and 2 c dancing up (to $2,1,3$ )

25- $3 c+1 c+2 c$ Allemande, at end 1c cast off and 3c dance up to $(2,3,1)$

17- L-Chain, end in promhold with $P$

17-- $\quad 2 \mathrm{~W}+1 \mathrm{M}$ (1W following) +3 M Rsh Diag. Reel3, 1c finish facing 1cnr

1c turn 1cnrs RH, pass Rsh (cnrs dance for $\{4\}$ ) ; turn 2cnrs RH (same), and cross Rsh to $(2,1,3)$
