#### 1 MILITARY TWO STEP X16 · 1RR

James Finnigan: A Guide to Scottish Country Dancing (ex-Collins) · Crib: SCDDB Contributed Cribs & Diagrams


Couples round the room facing anticlockwise, ladies on the men's right. Start with ladies' left hands on men's right shoulders, men's right arms loosely around ladies' waists.

- 1-2 Bouncing on the inner foot, touch heel then toe of outer foot to the ground twice.
- **3–4** Walk forward for three steps then turn towards partner to face in the opposite direction.
- **5–8** Repeat in the opposite direction, finishing facing partner.
- 9–10 With both hands joined, jump onto both feet, then kick right foot across left; jump onto both feet again, then kick left foot across right.
- The man raises his left hand (and the lady's right), dropping the other hand, and the lady (walking forward) turns once under the raised hands. Finish in ballroom hold.
- **13–16** Polka around the room, finish ready to start again.

- 1- 1c+2c & 3c+4c RHA; 1W & 4M (partners following) chase clw behind sidelines to other end (4x,2,3,1x)
- **9–** Repeat from new positions, to own places
- 17- 1c facing 2c & 3c facing 4c set | change places RH; 1c+4c repeat LH (2,4,1,3)
- 25- 1c & 4c dance out between nearest end couple and cast back; all C turn RH (2,4,1,3)






- 1- 1c+2c Poussette
- 9- 1c lead down {3}, up {3} and cast to 2pl (2c up) (2,1,3)
- 17- 1c+3c Tourbillon
- **25** Circle6 and back (2,3,1)


- 1- 1c Rsh fig8 on own side round 2c & 3c
- **9-** 1c+2c A&R; RHA (1,2,3)
- 17- 1c with 2c following lead down the middle and up (2c leading) (2,1,3)
- **25** Turn CPCP (2,1,3)



#### 5 THE SAINT JOHN RIVER \$32 \cdot 4/4L

- 1- 1W (1M following) cast off 1 place, cross to M side, cast off 1 pl, cross to W side, cast off 1 pl, cross to below 4M place opposite side (the meandering brook)
- 9- 1c dance (NHJ) up under arch by 4c {2}, 1½ BH turn {4}, dance up under arch by 2c to own places {2} (bridges and pools)




- 17- 1c lead down the middle, as 2c+3c+4c dance up the sides and follow; 4C casts from the top as the others lead up and cast, 1c casting too (1,2,3,4) (inverting waterfalls on the tidal lower river).
- 25- 1c+2c+3c+4c dance BtoB; 1M+2M & 1W+2W turn RH ½ {1}, 1M+3M & 1W+3W turn LH ½ {1}, 1M+4M & 1W+4W turn RH ½ {2} (river meets the sea)

### 6 THE COUNTESS OF DUNMORE'S REEL R32 · 3/4L

- 1- 1c set | dance down (2c up); cast up round 3c | set advancing to face 1cnr
- 9- 1c turn 1cnr RH, pass Rsh; turn 2cns RH, pass Rsh to face out in 2pl (cnrs dance for {4}) (2,1,3)
- 17- [3C Chain Progression] 1c cast ¼ clw round set while 2c & 3c Turn RH ¾ | 2M+3W turn LH 1½ while{4} the others promenade clw ½ round set | 3c+2c turn RH ¾ while 1c dance clw to 2pl (3.1.2)
- (3,1,2) 25- all chase ½ way clw; set | cross RH (2,1,3)





- 1- 1c cast off behind own lines; cast back to places
- 9- 1c turn RH | cast off (2c up); turn LH 1¼ into lines across, 1W up, 1M down
- All set twice, 1c petronella L (swiveling L) to own side on [19–20] (2,1,3); all set twice, 1c finishing BtoB facing own side for
- **25** DTr (2,1,3)



3C/4C longwise set.

#### **8 THE THORNHILL STRATHSPEY** \$32 \cdot 3/3L

- 1- 1c set, cast off (2c up), 2c+1c+3c set and ½ RH turn to face down
- 9- 2c+1c+3c Allemande starting down, end 2c+3c on opposite sides, 1c facing 3cnr positions (1cnr persons)
- 17- SetH&G , at end all set in lines across (1M below, 1W above)
- 25- All cross RH up/down (cnrs no polite turns) | 1c cast to R into 2plx; all couples cross RH | 1c & 3c change places LH on sidelines (2,3,1)

- 1- 1W+2M set | change places RH; 1c set to P | change places RH
- 9- 1c+2c Circle4 and back into line4 across in 1pl facing down (2W,2M,1W, 1M)
- 17- All dance down. On [20], all face P joining BH; 1c & 2c slip up to original places
- **25-** Poussette (2,1)



- 1- 1c+2c set | ½ RHA; set | cross RH (2,1,3)
- 9- 1c turn 1cnr RH and face 1cnr; ½ Reel4 on 1diag, 1c finish on sides in 2pl
- 17- 1c turn 2cnr LH and face 2cnr; ½ Lsh Reel4 on 2diag, finish on sides (3x, 1,2x)
- 25- All chase ½ cclw; 1c set | cross RH (2,1,3)



- 1-1c set | cast off; turn LH 11/4 into
- 9-1c+1cnrs BiL | 1c+1cnr turn RH {4} | repeat BiL
- 1c+cnrs Reels3 on the sides, Lsh to 17-2cnr, 1c finish LHJ and RHJ with 2cnr

25-1c+2cnr repeat [9-16]




Reels3 across, 1c Lsh to 3cnr, at end 1c cross RH as 2c+3c curve into place (2,1,3) 33-

- 9-All Reels3 across, Rsh to 1cnr, finishing (2,1x,3)
- 1c lead down | lead to the top; cross 17and cast to (2,1,3)
- 2c+1c R&L. 25-





- 9-Corners Pass and Cast Away: 1c+4cnrs pass RSh, cnrs turn RH 1/2, face each other and cast away to exchanged places as 1c meet P and turn RH to face 3cnrs; repeat with 3cnrs. On [16] 1c pass P RSh to 2plx (3x,1x,2x)
- 3C Set&Link twice (2,1,3) 17-
- 25-Circle6 and back (2,1,3)

- 25- 2c+1c+3c circle6 and back
